Verticality has been tested in all modern browsers: IE 9, Opera, Firefox, Safari and Chrome.

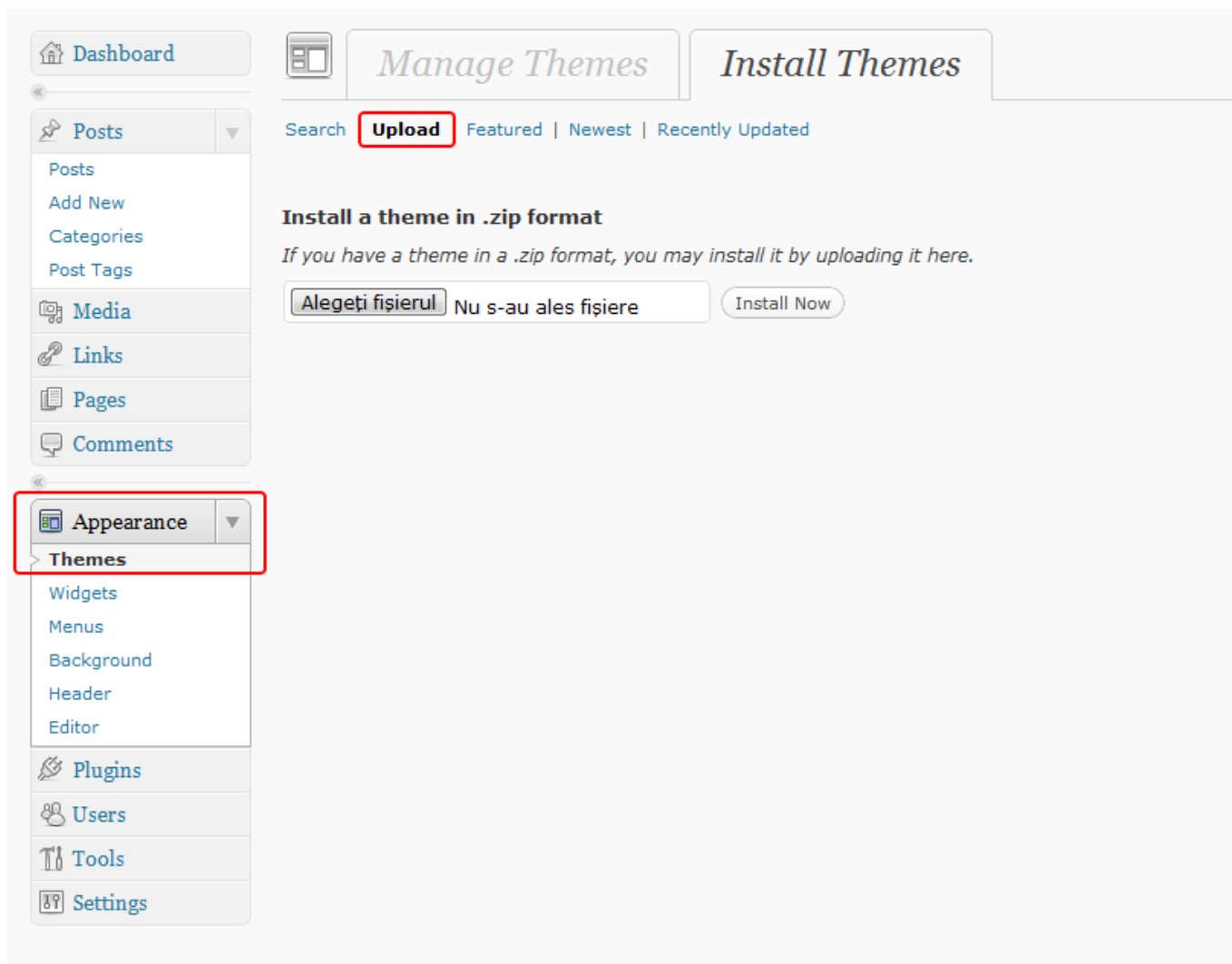

1. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to your WordPress Backend.
2. Open **Appearance - Themes - Install Themes**
3. Navigate to **Upload**
4. Browse for **.zip** file on your local computer, and Install it.
5. Then go to back to **Appearance - Themes**, and **Activate** theme



You can also upload the theme manually via FTP, into the folder `/wp-content/themes/`

After successful **activation**, go to the left side area of the backend to control Theme's specific settings.

It is recommended to label each element for better structure and control.

After choosing your content type you need to select the **view-type: list, grid** or **thumbnail view**.

Feel free to experiment with each option so you can choose the best layout.

Hint: Try to match the number of columns with the number of posts. E.g.: 3 columns – 3/6 posts, 4 columns – 4/8/16 posts, etc.

You can choose to add a background color or an image, or both. Also, you can insert a YouTube video or a Google Map iframe.

After successfully adding your first element press **UPDATE** to close the editing area.

You can add several elements for your mainpage and sort them by dragging each box.

Not the least, you need to set your default selected element. Start typing to select the desired page from the list of available elements you have created.

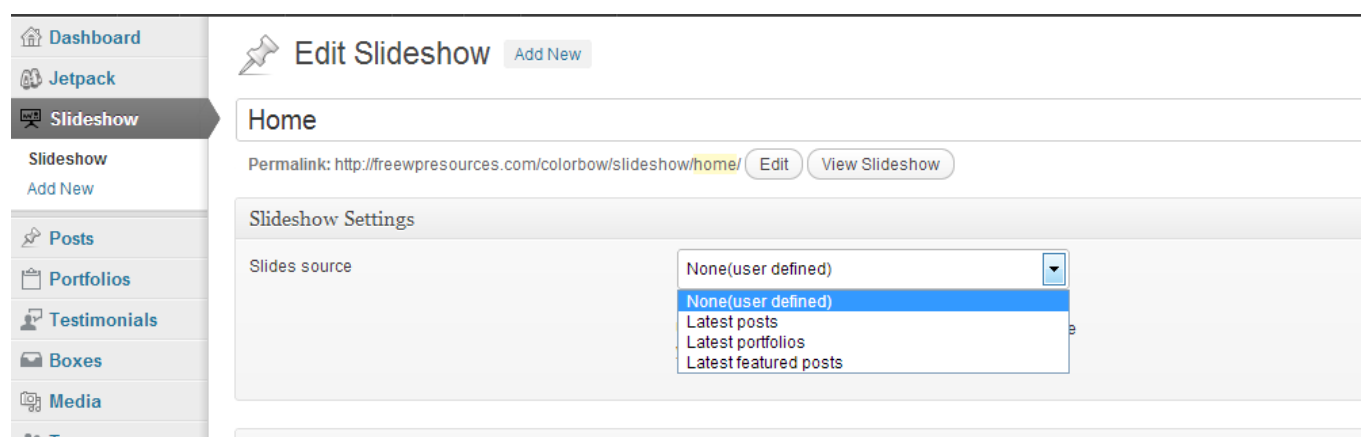
2.2 SLIDESHOW

To create a new slideshow press the **Add new** link in **Slideshow** menu item from the left side of your backend menu.

You can create an unlimited number of slideshows containing any amount of items and assign them for your mainpage.

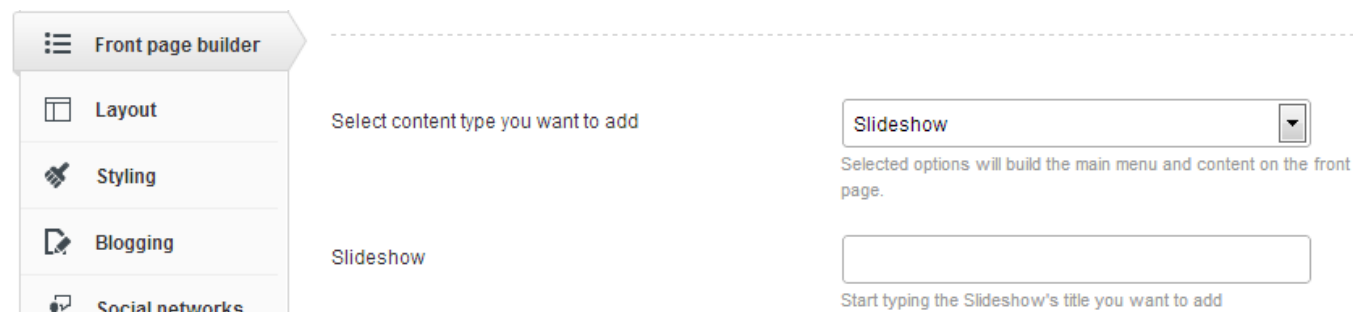
Slideshows can be composed from different resource types:

- User defined: Uploaded images or Extracted featured images from standard posts
- Automated slideshows created from Latest posts, Latest portfolios or Featured posts.



By default, if a slideshow item is composed from a post, the slide caption will be composed from the posts' title and excerpt/content. However, when using simple image or post type feel free to complete a different title, description or URL inputs.

To assign a slideshow to your mainpage select the **Slideshow** resource type from the dropdown menu in **Verticality – Mainpage builder**



Then, start typing the Slideshow's title you have created. It will automatically be added to your mainpage and menu.

Each slideshow can have individual settings such as animation type, timer timeout, etc.

2.3 GENERAL COLOR SCHEMES

The theme offers infinite color styles. Choose your preferred color for your Content area in **Verticality – Styling**. To set a background image go to **Appearance – Background**.

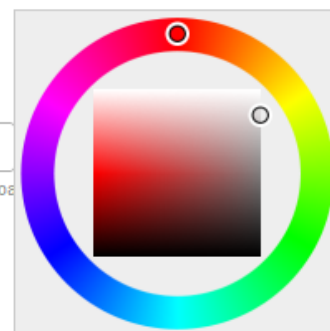

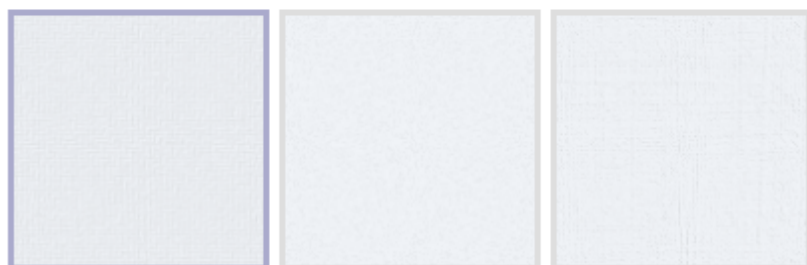



This option is available both for posts and pages.

If you choose the **Sidebar Layout** for your post, you can display different sidebars at your desire. Select which Widget Area will be shown for each particular post from the select bar below the **Post Layout**. By default, the Main Area will be shown.

You can add individual sidebars for specific posts. Create your New Sidebar then go to **Appearance – Widgets** and populate your Areas with desired Widgets.

CosmoThemes comes with 100+ shortcodes to choose from:

Each section comes with various options. After customizing your shortcode press **Insert**. The shortcode will be inserted in the above **Post** text area. Make sure not to delete or alter any inserted tags.

If you feel that the shortcode generates a defect layout make sure to eliminate any spaces and breaks between them.

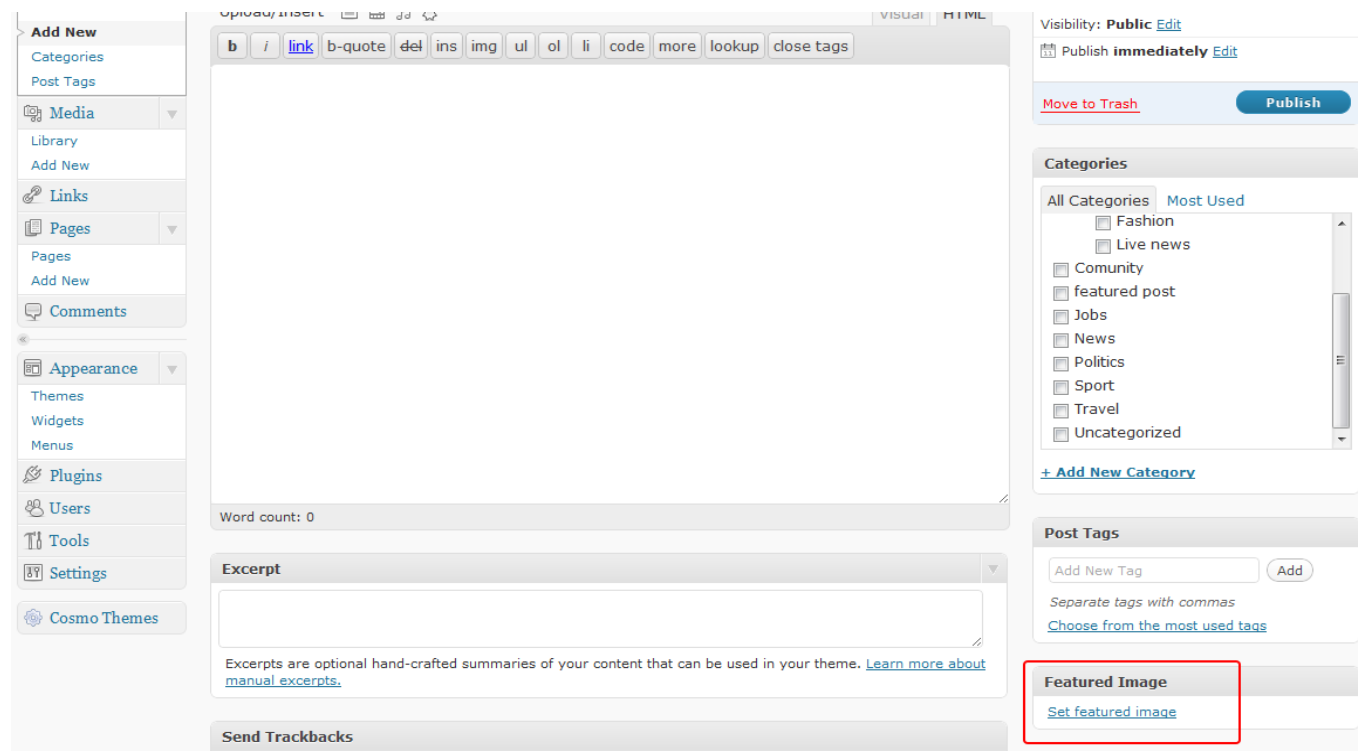
For each post/page you can choose which **meta** element will be shown or hidden. These values will override the default ones.

3.5 FEATURED IMAGES

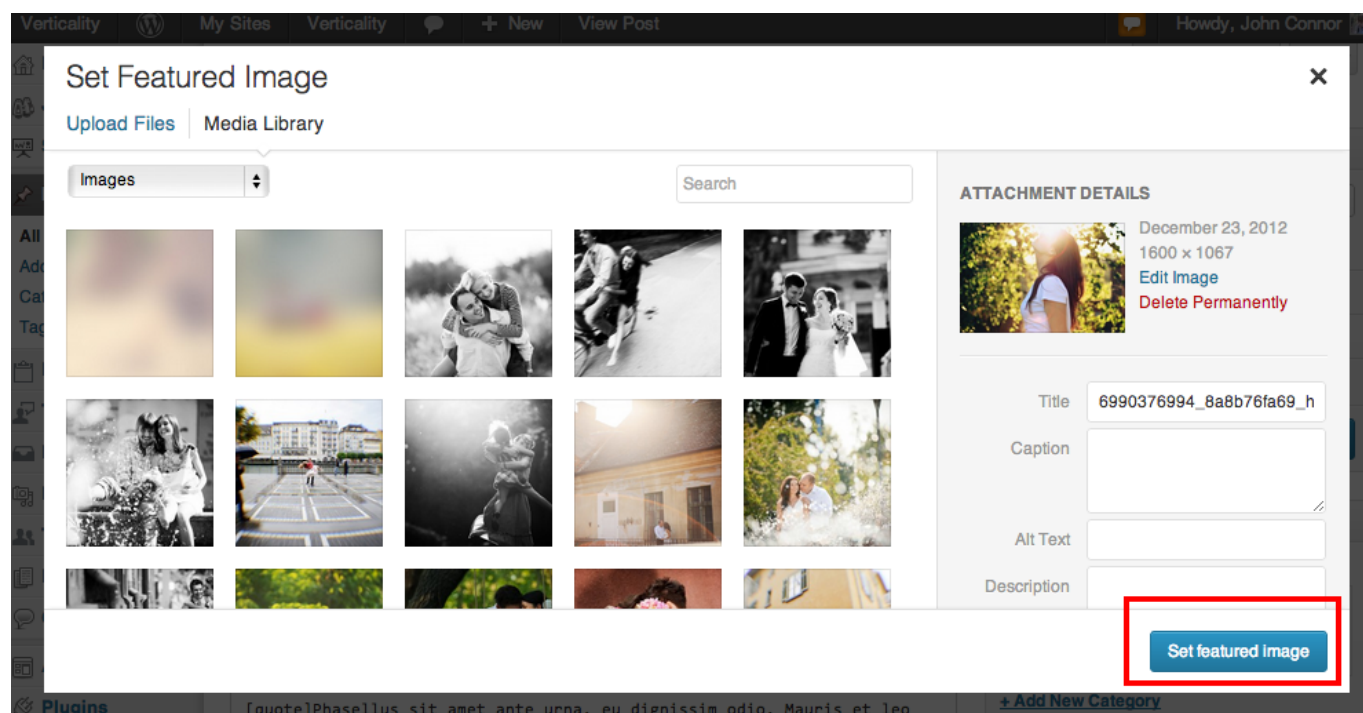
In order to use images for your posts please use **FEATURED IMAGES**.

You can show the featured Image both on the category/archive page and on single. Enable or disable it from **Verticality – General**.

When adding/editing a post, on the right side you will see a box: **Featured Image**.



Click on it, upload an image and then click the “use as featured image” link.



Don't forget to set the **Image Caption** to show users what the image is about.

3.6 POSTS LIKE

You can let users Love your posts by enabling this feature from **Verticality – Likes**
If enabled, set a limit of likes to turn your posts into Featured.

You can also generate a random number of likes for your posts.

After having a certain number of posts with enough Likes you can set your mainpage to show Featured posts.
Navigate to **Verticality – Mainpage** and select this resource type.

If you disable Love for posts, you can only select **New posts** and **Static page** for your mainpage.

3.7 POST FORMAT

Choose the corresponding format of the Post to correctly add a video, image, audio, attachment or standard post.

Using Youtube and Vimeo URLs for video posts will automatically set a [Featured image](#) for the post and crop all thumbnail sizes.

4. VIEW POST

4.1 SOCIAL SHARING

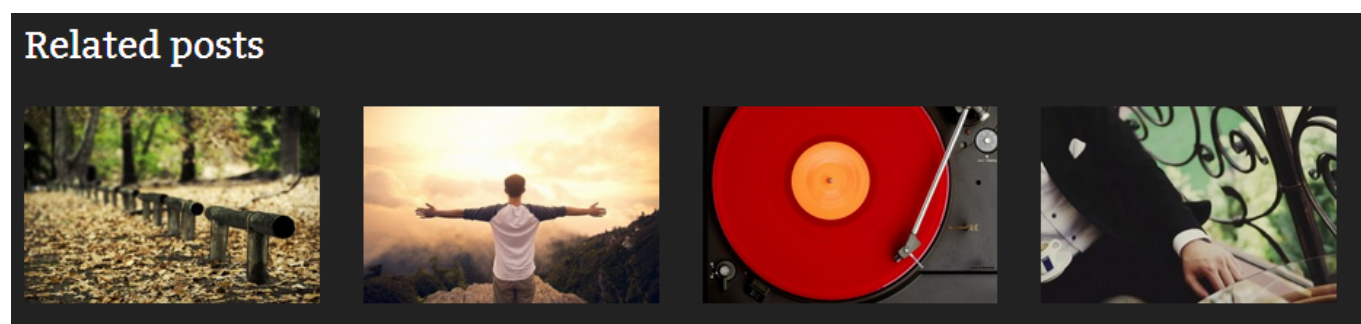
Each post by default has the Social Sharing feature enabled. It can be disabled from Theme's backend menu:

Verticality – Blogging.

4.2 RELATED POSTS

Similar posts feature shows up posts with the **same tags** or from **same category** at your will. If there are no other posts with the **same tags** or from **same category** than similar posts will not be shown.

Choose from backend how many similar posts to display for individual posts: **Verticality – Blogging**



4.3 NESTED COMMENTS

Go to **Settings – Discussion - Enable threaded (nested) comments X levels deep** and select the deepness level.

If you choose to disable nested comments, all the previous nested comments will be displayed as simple ones.

4.4 FACEBOOK COMMENTS

To enable Facebook comments go to **Verticality – Social Networks**

Insert your application ID so you can moderate comments, or choose other settings as:

- Make every post public by default
- Approve each comment before it appears
- Allow users to post using other login providers, etc.

5. TESTIMONIALS, BANNERS, BOXES AND TEAMS

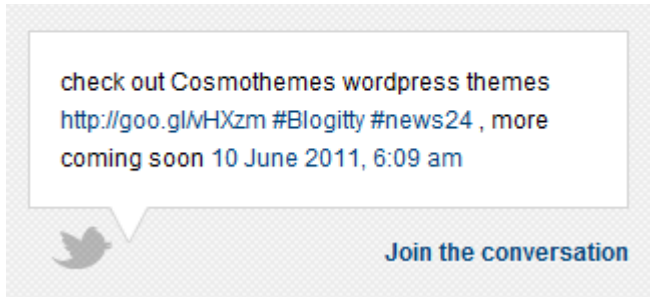
The theme comes with several built-in custom posts such as: testimonials, banners, boxes and teams.

Add content to each of these custom posts using the same rules as for standard posts: add title, content, featured images and fill in the specific custom fields, as Author name for Testimonials or Team member Facebook for Teams.

Teams and Boxes can be grouped into categories, called **sets** for boxes and **groups** for teams. Thus these custom posts can be displayed in frontend sorted by their category.

6. WIDGETS

6.1 TWITTER WIDGET



To display your Twitter posts go to **Appearance – Widgets** and drag and drop the **Latest Tweets** widget to one of desired **Sidebars**. Then set the Twitter **username** and the **number** of latest tweets you want to show.

Choose between the **animated** version and static one. The animated version will display 1 tweet at a time.

6.2 QUICK CONTACT FORM WIDGET

To display Contact Form Widget go to **Appearance – Widgets** and drag and drop the **Quick Contact Form** widget to one of the **Footer Widget Area**. Then set your **desired email** and press **Save**.

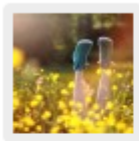
6.4 TABBER WIDGET

To display Hot and New posts, Latest Comments and Tags drag and drop the Tabber Widget to one of your sidebars.

Set values to display the desired number of entries.

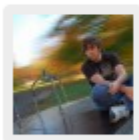
If Facebook comments are enabled there will be only 3 tabs: hot, new and tags.

6.5 TOP AUTHOR WIDGET

In order for the Top Author Widget to function you need to install the WordPress JetPack plugin available at:

<http://wordpress.org/extend/plugins/jetpack/>

This plugin will enable posts and author statistics that will calculate top authors by a certain period of time.

6.6 CATEGORIES WITH ICONS

To use an enhanced Category Widget go to **Appearance – Widgets** and drag and drop the **Category Icons** widget.

You can select an icon for each category from the provided drop-down list.

The icons list is automatically generated from the images names located in
/\$theme_directory\$/images/category_icons/

So, simply upload a new png image sized 16x16px and it will appear in the widget's dropdown list.

7. LANGUAGES

Firstly you'll need a tool allowing you to translate .po file into your language.

You can use Poedit app, or CodeStyling WordPress Plugin.

Open .po file from /languages/ folder of the theme, and start translating each word to your language.

After you finished, click button "Save Catalog", and it will create a new .mo file in the same folder.

Then you'll need to open wp-config.php file from the root folder of your WordPress install, and replace this line:

```
define ('WPLANG', '');
```

with something like:

```
define ('WPLANG', 'fr_FR');
```

Then make sure that .mo file from /languages/ folder of our theme has the same name as your language code:
"fr_FR.mo"
